Supply, delivery and installation of new LED track and tube lights in all National Museum of Fine Arts galleries

. OVERVIEW

As with other museums affected by the lockdowns due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the National Museum of the Philippines (NMP) management has recallibrated its programs to conform to the "new normal". The NMP considers this as waiting for the proper and safe time to fully reopen and accept guests again at its full capacity. opportunity to improve visitor experience in its galleries and exhibitions while

At present, FAD relies on the supply of these lights from available stocks at the Facilities Management Division
