## **Description**

### INVITATION TO BID FOR

MODERNIZATION OF THREE (3) UNITS PASSENGER ELEVATOR AT THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY (NMNH) BUILDING

1. The NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES, through the General Fund FY 2021 intends to apply the sum and project indicated below, being the ABC to payment under the contract for each lot.

- 1 Modernization of "MP Brand" Hydraulic Passenger Elevator (1150 kgs. Capacity x2 Stops) Php 1,980,000.00
- 2 Modernization of "Autors Schneider Brand" Double Entrance Passenger Elevator (2000 kgs. Capacity x5 Stops) Php 1,980,000.00
- 3 Modernization of "Autors Schneider Brand" Passenger Elevator (800 kgs. Capacity x5 Stops) Php 1,540,000.00 Total Approved Budget for the Contract Php 5,500,000.00

Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- 2. The NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods and Services is required One Hundred Five (105) Calendar Days. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail"

criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from Monday Friday at 9:30 A.M.- 2:30 P.M.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on 20 August 2021 from the given address below and website http://nationalmuseum.gov.ph and upon payment of the applicable non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) per lot. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person, or through electronic means.
- 6. The NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 27 August 2021, 10:30 A.M. at Old Civil Service Building, National Museum of the Philippines, Padre Burgos Street, Manila which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below. LATE BIDS SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on 10 September 2021, 10:30 A.M. at Old Civil Service Building, National Museum of the Philippines, Padre Burgos Street, Manila. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

The NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
