## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### SUPPLY AND PRINTING OF EXHIBITION COLLATERALS FOR **MALANG: A RETROSPECTIVE EXHIBITION OF MAURO MALANG SANTOS**

#### I. INTRODUCTION

The National Museum of the Philippines honors and celebrates the artistic excellence of renowned artist Mauro "Malang" Santos through a retrospective exhibition to be organized by its Fine Arts Division (FAD) in Gallery XXI of the National Museum of Fine Arts.

This exhibition, tentatively entitled "Malang", will feature an extensive selection of works from the artist's family, the National Fine Arts Collection, and from select partner institutions. The FAD will be closely working with the artist's son, Soler Santos, and curators Susan de Guzman and Giselle Kasilag in the planning, designing, production, and implementation stages of the exhibition. Furthermore, the curators will be assisting in the production of an exhibition catalogue.

The Malang exhibition and its catalogues are targeted to be launched and opened to the public on January 20, 2022 in celebration of the artist's 94th birth anniversary.

For the implementation of the abovementioned project, the National Museum of the Philippines shall be engaging the service of a printing service specialist which shall also adhere to the international museum standards.

#### II. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work under this contract comprises the printing and exhibition collaterals listed below for the abovementioned exhibition:

##### 1. Construction, Paint and Electrical Supplies and Materials

Quality materials are needed for the fabrication of stable, sturdy, and secured display systems of the exhibition.

The project must be completed within 30 working days and should be stipulated in the contractor's commitment of their contract to the National Museum of the Philippines.

**VI. QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDER**

The bidder must be able to comply with the requirements, terms and conditions set by the NMP Bids and Awards Committee (BAC). They shall also provide samples for the end-user's quality check prior to the completion of the printing and delivery.

**VII. PROCUREMENT PROCESS**

Procurement of the services of a contractor for the above-mentioned project shall ~~be in accordance with the provisions of the Government Procurement Reform Act (RA 9184)~~ and its revised implementing rules and regulations.


