I. OBJECTIVE

The National Museum of the Philippines (NMP) is a government institution that serves as an educational, scientific, and cultural inspiration in the preservation and public presentation of the various permanent national collections featuring the ethnographic, anthropological, archaeological, and visual artistry. The NMP aims to strengthen public safety and promoting fire safety environment through the prevention and suppression of all kinds of destructive fires. The Republic Act (RA) No. 9514, otherwise known as the "Fire Code of the Philippines of 2008", is now more stringent in implementing fire safety measures and requirements. One of these requirements is the installation of fire facilities and equipments such as the fire extinguishers which have been proven to be a great help in ensuring fire safety, mitigating damage of property in NMP collections & premises and preventing loss of life among NMP occupants caused by fire.

The Security Management Section under Office of the Director-General (SMS-ODG) invites interested parties to bid for the refill and recondition of the portable fire extinguishers located in NMP Central Offices; National Museum of Fine Arts (NMFA); National Museum of Anthropology (NMA); and National Museum of Natural History, in compliance with the requirements of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) yearly.

II. APPROVED BUDGETARY REQUIREMENTS

The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of the procurement of refill and recondition of the portable fire extinguishers is in accordance with the NMP Annual Procurement Plan (APP) FY 2022. The ABC is amounting to **Three Hundred Four Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Five Pesos Only (P304,575.00)** inclusive of all applicable taxes. See Annex A for the Cost Breakdown and Annex B for the Inventory List.

III. SUPPLIER'S ELIGIBILITY

The supplier is required to submit at least one (1) similar contracts (e.g. Projects completed that entailed supply and delivery of various fire extinguishers) awarded and completed from year 2017 up to present with an amount of at least 50% of the ABC.

The supplier must be the authorized dealer, supplier, and/ or, the manufacturer of the fire extinguisher being offered.

VI. COMPLIANCE TO THE CONTRACT



Form of warranty shall be as specified in accordance with section 62.2.3.3 of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

- Liquidated damages when the contractor fails to satisfactorily deliver any or all of the Goods and/or perform the Services under the contract within the specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the contractor shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, an amount equal to 1/10 of 1% of the cost of the delayed contract scheduled for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by the procuring entity concerned. In no case shall the sum of the liquidated damages exceed 10% of the total contract price, in which the procuring entity concerned may rescind the contract and impose appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages.


