**I. BACKGROUND**

The Research, Collections and Conservation Management Division (RCCMD) is the responsible unit for the procurement of chemical requirements of research divisions at National Museum of the Philippines. RCCMD determines the chemical requirements by working in coordination with the Chemical Management Committee (CMC) whose task is to evaluate, monitor and recommend any actions related to acquisition and utilization of chemicals.

**II. OBJECTIVE**

To acquire chemicals that will support the needs of the research divisions in the conservation, preservation, cleaning and maintenance of museum collections.

**III. SCOPE OF WORK**

It will be expected of the service provider to receive and translate government orders and deliver the chemicals in terms of the stipulated agreement and timeframe.

**IV. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**

All chemicals to be delivered must be packed well, properly labeled and new stocks. Details about the ingredients/components/specifications, manufacturing date and expiration date of the chemicals must be clearly indicated on the labels.


