

RESOLUTION No. 2022 - 51

**RELOCATION OF ELECTRICAL LOADS FROM 2 UNITS OLD LVSG TO NEW LVSG AT
NMFA**

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines, through the Bids and Awards Committee (Committee), intends to acquire, by means of Public Bidding, a bonafide merchant for the project mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 2,500,000.00)** chargeable against General Fund FY 2022;

WHEREAS, on 11 July 2022 an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPs) and in the BAC Bulletin Board, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, five (5) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz: Commission on Audit (COA); National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Philippine Chamber and Industry Plaza, Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., and Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, on 19 July 2022 a Pre-Bidding Conference was held to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents, and others;

WHEREAS, on 4 August 2022 the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids, attended and participated by four (4) bidders, namely:

- (1) Ayzariz Corporation, (Ayzariz, for brevity);
- (2) DLL & Sons Co. Asia Ltd. Inc., (DLL, for brevity);
- (3) Pointer Enterprises, (Pointer, for brevity);
- (4) DEL'S Electrical and General Services Inc., (DEL'S, for brevity);

WHEREAS, Ayzariz, DLL and Pointer's passed the technical, and financial components based on RA 9184 as checked by the Committee using the pass or fail non-discretionary criteria for evaluation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected DLL's to Post Qualification Evaluation, being the lowest calculated bid after the bid evaluation conducted by the Committee;

WHEREAS, the TWG, after thorough and proper evaluation, confirmed and declared DLL & Sons Co. Asia Ltd. Inc. as post-qualified and responsive to the requirement set for the aforementioned project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommend as we hereby **RECOMMENDS** that the project, **RELOCATION OF ELECTRICAL LOADS FROM 2 UNITS OLD LVSG TO NEW LVSG AT NMFA**, be awarded to **DLL & Sons Co. Asia Ltd. Inc.**, with a contract amount of **Two Million One Hundred Ninety Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos and Seventy-One Centavos (Php 2,190,964.71)**.
