

RESOLUTION No. 2022 - 54

Supply, Fabrication, Printing, and Installation of Ethnographic and Archaeological Exhibition and the Asin Tibuok Proto-Industry at Gallery V of National Museum Bohol

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines, through the Bids and Awards Committee (Committee), intends to acquire, by means of Public Bidding, a bonafide merchant for the project mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **Two Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Pesos and Fifty-Two Centavos (Php 2,999,880.52)** chargeable against Continuing Fund FY 2021;

WHEREAS, on 6 July 2022 an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and in the BAC Bulletin Board, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, five (5) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz Commission on Audit (COA); National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Philippine Chamber and Industry Plaza, Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., and Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, on 14 July 2022 a Pre-Bidding Conference was held to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents, and others;

WHEREAS, on 28 July 2022 the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids, attended and participated by two (2) bidders, namely:

- (1) Red Root Artists and Artisan Multi-Purpose Coop. (Red Roots, for brevity);
- (2) Nikko Metal Works (Nikko Metal, for brevity);

WHEREAS, all bidders passed the eligibility, technical, and financial check performed by the Committee using the pass or fail non-discretionary criteria for evaluation, hence, the BAC read and evaluated their bids as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected Red Root to Post Qualification Evaluation, being the lowest calculated bid after the bid evaluation conducted by the Committee;

WHEREAS, the TWG, after thorough and proper evaluation, confirmed and declared Red Root as post-qualified and responsive to the requirement set for the aforementioned project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommend as we hereby **RECOMMENDS** that the project, **Supply, Fabrication, Printing, and Installation of Ethnographic and Archaeological Exhibition and the Asin Tibuok Proto-Industry at Gallery V of National Museum Bohol**, be awarded to **Red Root Artists and Artisan Multi-Purpose Cooperative**, with a contract amount of **Two Million Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos and Three Centavos (PhP 2,780,347.03).**


