

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made the SEP 27 2022 day of 20 between
**NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES, National Museum Complex, Rizal Park,
Manila, 1000, Philippines** (hereinafter called "the Museum") of the one part **RED ROOT
ARTISTS AND ARTISANS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE, #62-B
Mapagkawangawa St., Teacher's Village East, Quezon City** (hereinafter called "the
Service Provider") of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Museum invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly **Supply, Fabrication, Printing and Installation of Ethnographic and Archaeological Exhibition and Asin Tibuok Proto-Industry at Gallery V of National Museum Bohol** and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **Two Million Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos and Three Centavos (PHP 2,780,347.03)** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

WHEREAS, the drafting and preparation of the Contract was conducted on
September 02, 2022.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;


Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;

- iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conformed thereto; and
 - v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
3. In consideration for the sum **Two Million Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Seven Pesos and Three Centavos (PHP 2,780,347.03)** or such other sums as may be ascertained part **RED ROOT ARTISTS AND ARTISANS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE** agrees to the **Supply, Fabrication, Printing and Installation of Ethnographic and Archaeological Exhibition and Asin Tibuok Proto-Industry at Gallery V of National Museum Bohol** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.


4. The **NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.






